Bryan Lee Webb was born on December 7, 1943 to Henry and Clara Webb with a brother and two sisters welcoming his arrival in Guion, Texas. Bryan passed away peacefully January 11, 2023 with friends and family by his side. Bryan graduated from Winters High School in 1962 and Texas A&M University in 1966.

He felt God's call soon after to join Campus Crusade for Christ in San Bernardino, California and worked in the audio/visual department. A long ways from Winters, but God had special plans for him. He met (who he called his Kansas Sunflower) Marcella Schrag who was also working there. Their relationship blossomed and got married in 1970. In 1973, he felt God's call to move back to the farm when Bryan's father needed help with the crops and cows. God blessed him with 2 wonderful farm hands and fishing buddies. Bryan retired from farming in 2005 and took care of the yard work at First Baptist Church in Winters where he attended until fully retiring in 2007. He was also a deacon, Sunday School teacher and regularly attended the Thursday early morning prayer group that was started about 25 years ago. This is a special group of men that Bryan loved to be a part of and blessed to lead the singing.

He is preceded by his father and mother, one brother Bob Webb and two sisters Alice Smith and Virginia Rhodes and one son Kevin Webb.

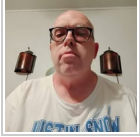
