Estella Augusta Theresa Bredemeyer, age 93, passed from this earth on November 14, 2019, at the Ballinger Healthcare & Rehab.

She lived her entire life in Runnels County, graduating from Winters High School in 1943. In 1944, she went to work at the Winters State Bank and continued in banking for the next 40 plus years.
