Mary Beatrice Arispe, Age 83, of Winters, Texas, passed away on Saturday, March 23rd, in her home. She was born to Fidel and Julia Lujano in Whitsett, Texas, on August 18th, 1940. She is preceded in death by her parents, Fidel and Julia Lujano, and her son Jerry Arispe.
