The family of Paul Michaels regrettably announce his passing on August 10th, 2023.

Paul Elo Michaelis is survived by his three children, Michael "Mike" Michaelis (beloved daughter in law Jennifer Michaelis), Robin Hale (beloved son in law Jeff Hale), and Jennifer "J.J." Zenuch (beloved son in law Jeff Zenuch); and his grandchildren, Sam Hale, Kendall Michaelis, Austin Zenuch, and Alex Zenuch.

Mr. Michaelis was preceded in death by his parents LeBelle Michaelis and Elo Michaelis.

Mr. Michaelis was born in Abilene, Texas in 1937 but grew up in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He attended the University of Arkansas and graduated with a degree in mathematics. In 1961 he entered the U.S. Army Southeastern Signal School in Fort Gordon, Georgia and was trained as a lineman. He was released from active duty and served five more years in the U.S. Army Reserves at Fort Hood, Texas as an Ammunition Storage Specialist. After the passing of his father, Mr. Michaelis took on the management of the Michaelis Ranch in Wingate, Texas where he resided until his death.

Per his wishes, his memorial service will be private with his immediate family.
