



Richard Puckett

December 27, 1947 - June 26, 2023

On June 26, 2023, Richard Lee Puckett, 75, passed away on his family farm.

Richard was raised in Pumphrey and attended school in Winters. He was class President throughout high school while also leading the Blizzards as their 4-year starting Quarterback (logging time on the other side of the ball at defensive back). He attended college at McMurry, leading the Indians as their starting quarterback for four years and earned the NAIA All-American status, never missing a game. He was inducted into the McMurry Hall of Honor twice; first as part of the 1971 Indians and later receiving individual honors in 2011. Richard still ranks among the all-time McMurry career passing leaders. He was an original dual threat quarterback (before anyone knew the term), he ran for his life, and he led his Tribe.

Richard was a spiritual man and a member of the Masonic Lodge in Wingate. He served in the National Guard and was an Air Force Reserve, ending his military career as a Staff Sergeant.

When Richard finished college, he initially worked as an Exxon USA sales representative and later as a real estate acquisition and placement specialist. Richard was a farm-boy who never enjoyed being confined to an office, so he eventually chose a career as a self-employed Exxon independent dealer until he retired in 2019. He was passionate about family, fishing, hunting, football

and baseball.

Richard is preceded in death by his father B.C. "Freck" Puckett and his mother Neva Colburn. He is survived by his wife Robbie (Davidson) Puckett, his brother Chester ("Chip") Puckett, and his two children Blake Puckett and Courtney Puckett Richardson. He is also survived by four grandsons Alex, Evan, Jake, and Hayes, and his great-granddaughter Hadlee.
