



## Robert Charles Schwartz, Sr

Robert Charles Schwartz, Sr. age 96 passed away Sunday, February 16, 2020 at the Henderson Health & Rehabilitation Center.

He was born May 31, 1923 in Crews, TX, the son of the late Charles William and Ruby Berd Cox Schwartz. He graduated high school in Winters, TX and received a mechanical engineering degree from Texas Tech University. He married Velma Carol Stumbo in 1946 and they made their home in the Lubbock, TX area. She preceded in death in 1960. He was district engineer for Anderson Clayton Paymaster Division and later Continental Moss Gordon Cotton Gin Equipment and later Johnson Manufacturing in Lubbock.
