Her family was actively involved in the Christadelphian Church in San Angelo, Texas where she made lifelong friends. As an adult, she was a member of First Christian Church in San Angelo, Texas.

Vicki grew up in Ballinger, Texas. She was a lifelong Bearcat and even as her memories faded she never forgot Ballinger or the Bearcats, often speaking of the football games and the band. "Go Big Red!" She graduated from Ballinger High School in 1970. She went on to attend business school in Abilene, Texas.

She married the love of her life, Ricki Lynn Cummings on May 12, 1973. As a couple they lived in Winters, Abilene, and Sunray, Texas. Their final move was to San Angelo in 1977. For 40 years, this is where she worked and raised her family.

In 1984, her life took an unexpected turn. With her faith in Jesus and the support of her family she began an almost 30 year career in the abstract/title business. She began working at Poulter Abstract & Title Company where she became not only a greatly valued employee but was blessed to be part of the
